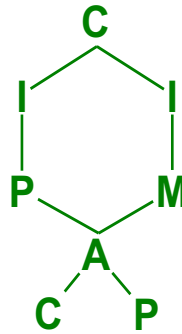

If you intend to have an oral presentation or a poster at the CIPAC symposium, you are kindly asked to send an abstract with the professional details of the presenter to Ralf Hänel (by e-mail, see above).

I am looking forward to meeting you in Braunschweig and thank you for the contribution to the work of CPAC.
