A. Regulatory affairs:

Administrative Reform

The prime minister's proposal for reforming the administrative structure of 22 ministries and agencies into 11 organizations was implemented. In the flow of the current restructuring, the Agricultural Chemicals Inspection Station under the supervision of MAFF to which pesticide registration application shall be filed, Fertilizer and Feed Inspection Station under the supervision of MAFF, and Center for Food Quality, Labeling and Consumer Service under the supervision of MAFF were merged into one independent organization under the name of Food and Agriculture Materials Inspection Center on April 2007. New Center shall be responsible for ensuring the safety of food in the field of technical aspect throughout every channel from the farm to the family dining table for the sake of consumers.
