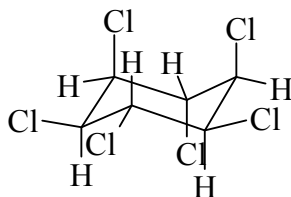

Dr. Miles remarked that the old WHO method (columnchromatography) was tedious and obsolete. Mr. Lovett and Dr. Kotarski would send their GLC methods.

CIPAC 26th meeting, May 1982 in Rome

Mr. Miles reported that he would start a study with a GLC method to replace the difficult WHOColumnchromatography method. He would circulate an Information Sheet via the secretary.

CIPAC 27th meeting, July 1983 in Brisbane

The GLC method presented at the symposium was accepted as full WHOCIPAC method (published in 1C).
