Mr. Pawliczek presented the report of a small scale study performed by DAPA. It was astudy with a capillary GLC method on 1 TC and 2 SC's, one of them with a second a.i. The replacement of He by  $N_2$  had not been tested. It was remarked that an identity test might be necessary to determine whether or not it is a mixture of the four diastereomers. The results of the study were good, a CIPAC study will be started soon.
