Mr Dobrat reported that the trial was going on. Several questions were raised e.g. what the purpose was of the test, if it would be a required test in any authorization system of specification, haw the seed to be analysed were taken from the sample, and if any standard for acceptance had been formulated. So far in Germany it was required to give information about the distribution and its homogeneity. The general feeling was that the test should not be required in specifications although it might be good to have available a test.

CIPAC 37th meeting, June 1993 in Paris

Mr Menschel introduced the report of a CIPAC collaborative study on the determination of uniform distribution of liquid seed treatment formulations, CIPAC/3749. <u>Decision</u> The method for determining the uniform distribution of liquid seed treatment formulations on treated seeds, CIPAC/3750, has been adopted as <u>provisional</u> CIPAC method.
