Secretary's report

2022 – 2023

1. Previous meeting

The 66th meeting was held on Tuesday 14th and Wednesday 15th June 2022 using on-line communication tools. 104 people participated including members, correspondents, observers, representatives of industry.

Reports of seven full scale collaborative trials, six small scale trials and three method extensions were presented.

The status of four provisional methods was changed to full CIPAC method. Thirteen methods were accepted as provisional CIPAC methods.

2. Elections

Two colleagues were elected as correspondent members and two colleagues as full CIPAC members.

3. CIPAC publications

The accepted full and provisional methods are available as pre-published methods on the CIPAC website, until the publication of the next handbook.

4. Collaborative studies

In the time period covered by the report three full scale collaborative studies and five small scale studies were initiated and one study for method extension. The results will be presented on the technical meeting in Braunschweig. It worth also noted that activities started to update the CIPAC method validation guideline.
