### 3. CIPAC Activities

#### i) Small scale collaboration on amisulbrom (789)

The small scale collaborative trial on amisulbrom was conducted under the supervision of JAPAC. The statistical evaluation was carried out and the results will be submitted to CIPAC for the approval of proceeding to a large scale collaborative trial.

#### ii) Method extension for the determination of permethrin in the long lasting insecticidal net (331/LN/M/3)

In order to determine the content of permethrin in the permethrin/piperonyl butoxide long lasting insecticidal net with the existing CIPAC method (CIPAC 331/LN/M/3), a few minor modifications

were required. Therefore, the validity of the extension of existing CIPAC method was checked under the supervision of JAPAC to extend the defined analytical method. The statistical evaluation was carried out and the result was within the normal range.

iii) Briefing session on the activity of JAPAC

In order to widely promote understanding of the CIPAC and JAPAC activities, we held the briefing session on 20 January, where about 30 people from 14 companies attended.
